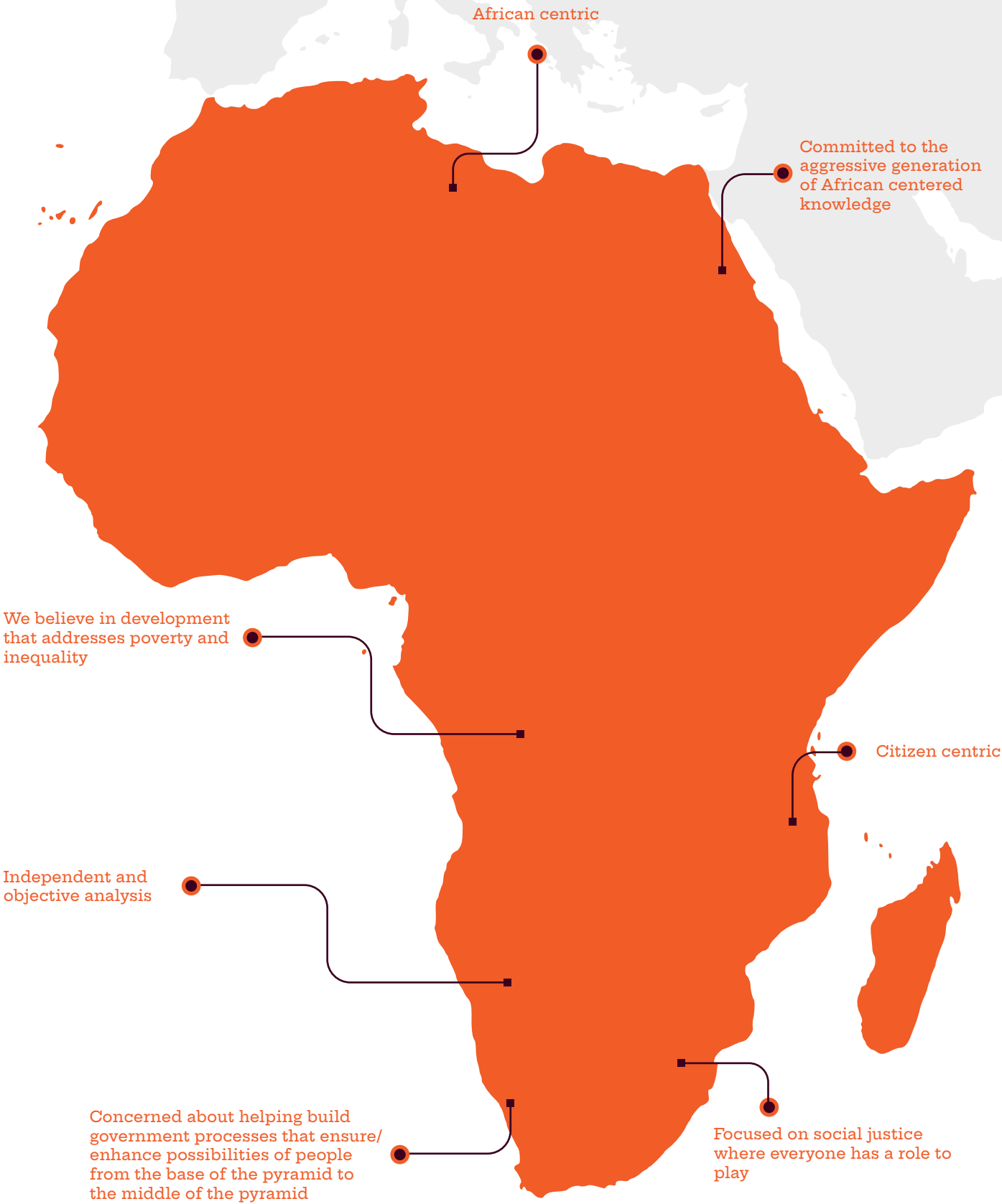

World View

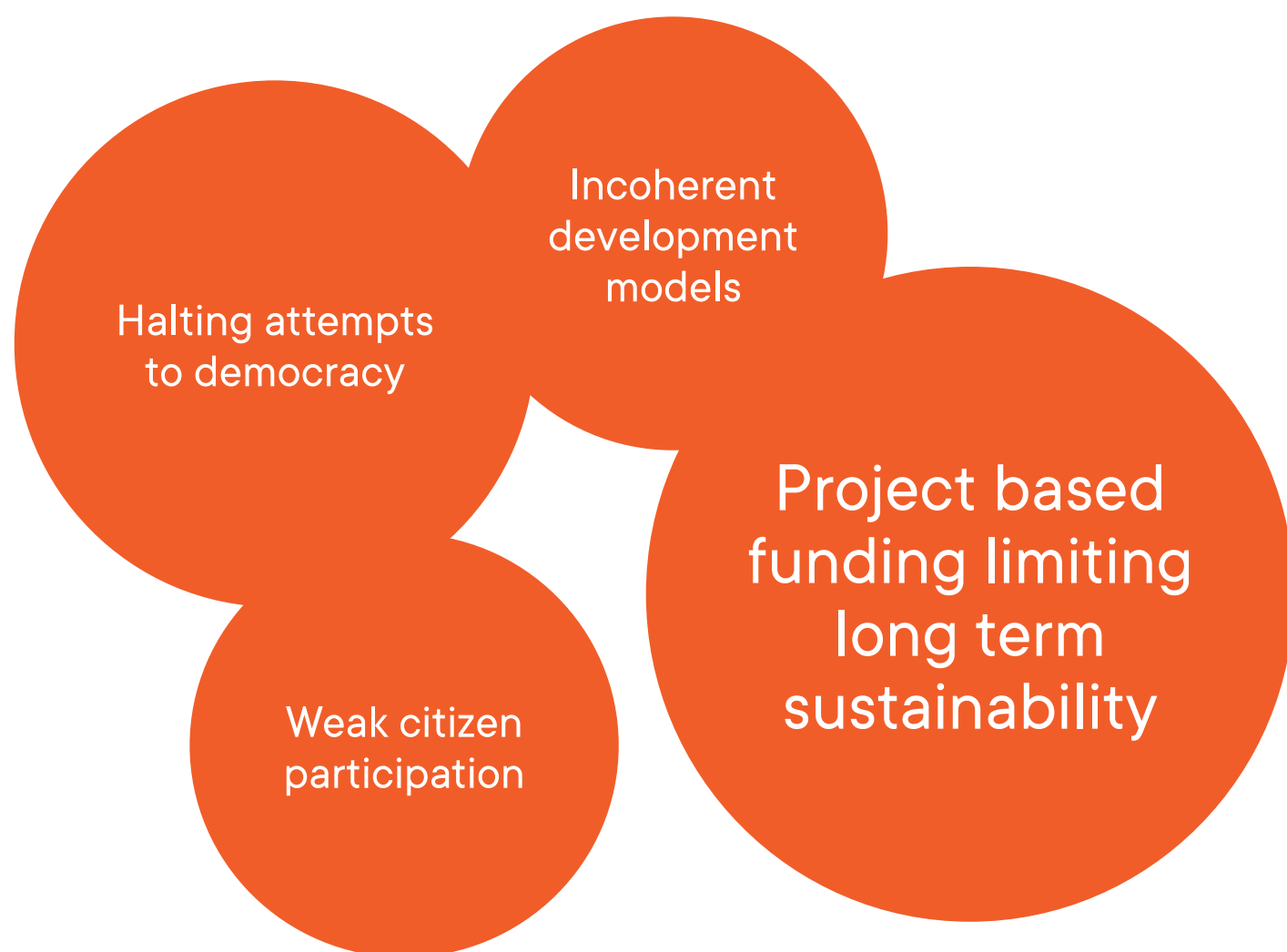


We are building upon the tradition of speaking truth to power, exploring opportunities for pathways to viable democracies and inclusive development with African characteristics.

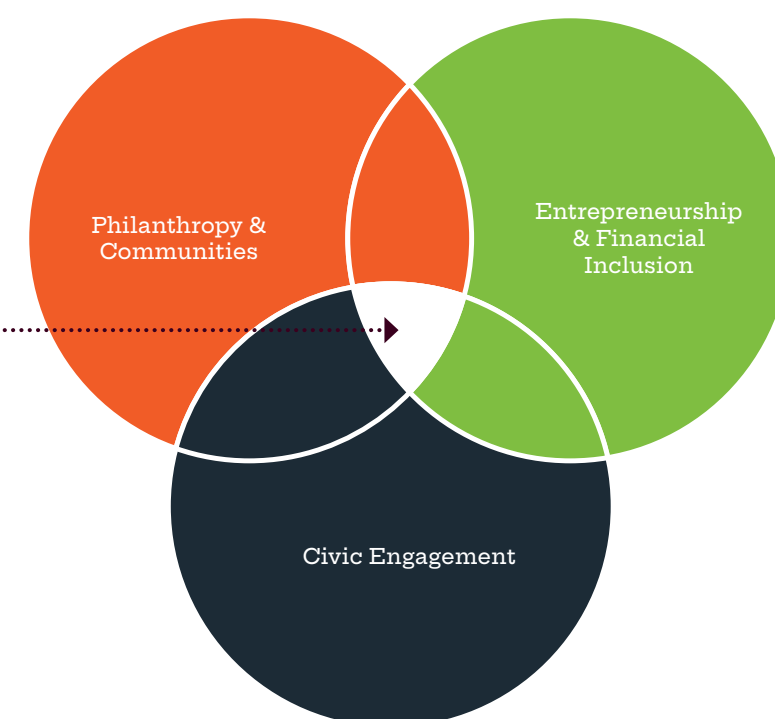


Center based approach

4. Organisational development

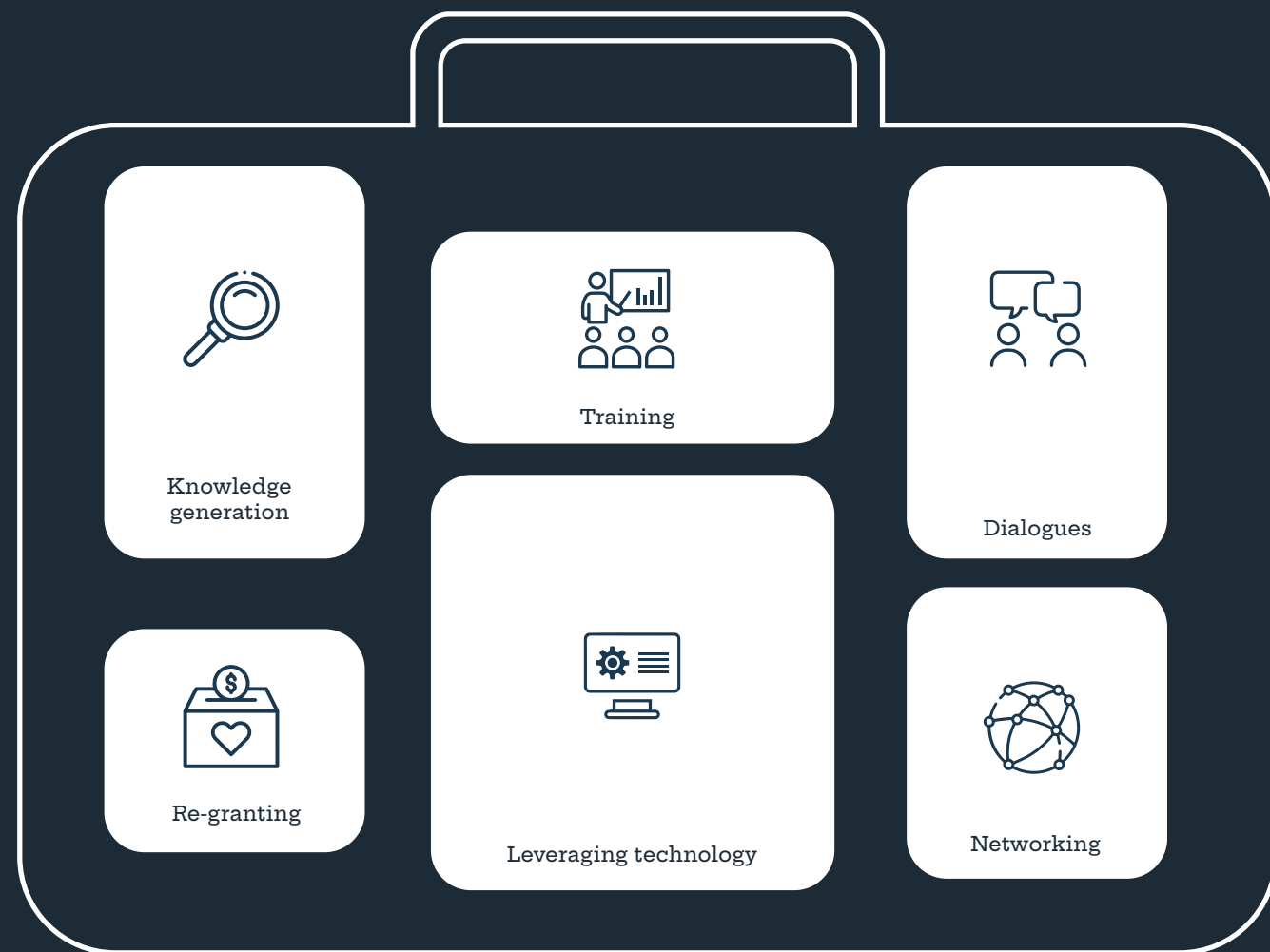

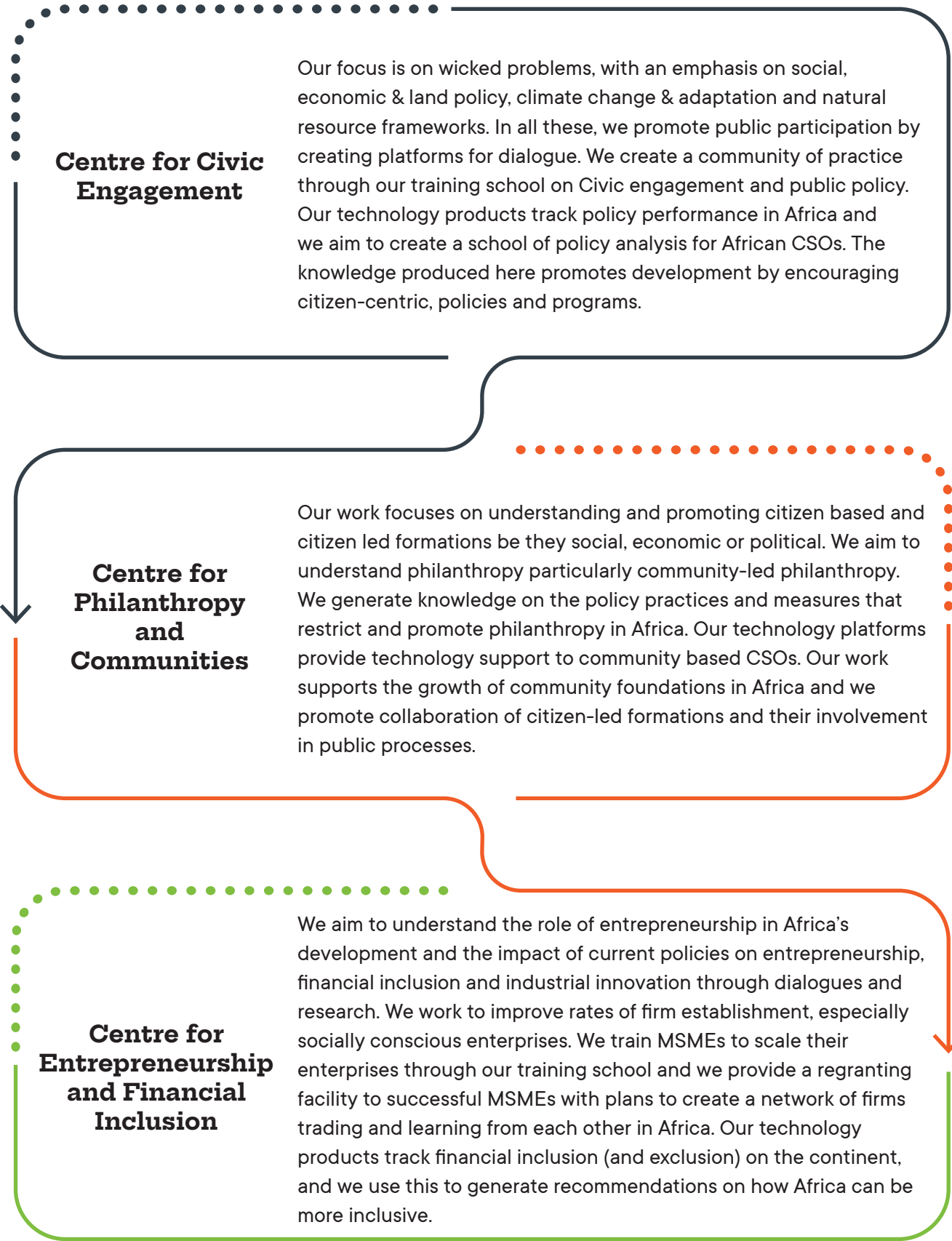
At SIVIO, we are continuously engaged in a process of incremental innovation.

- Institutional strengthening and resilience initiative

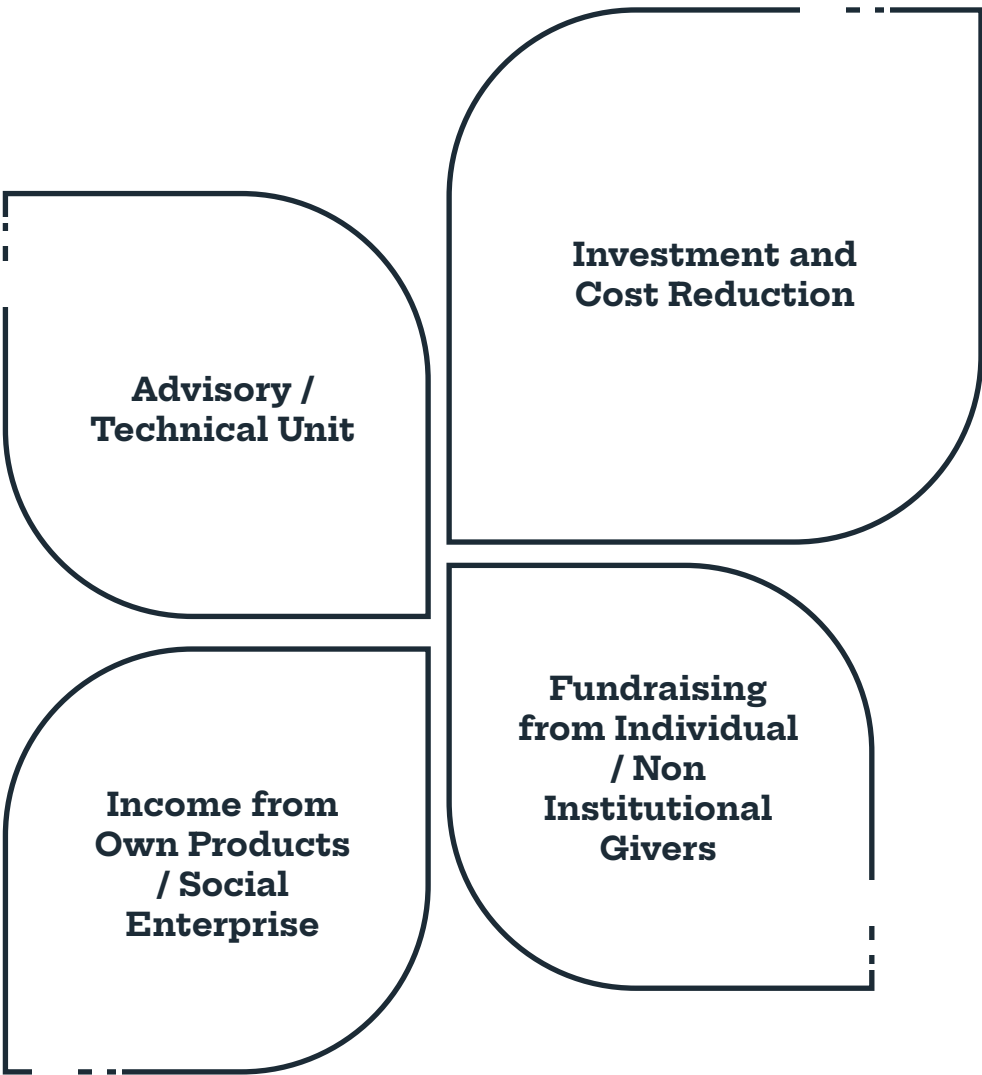

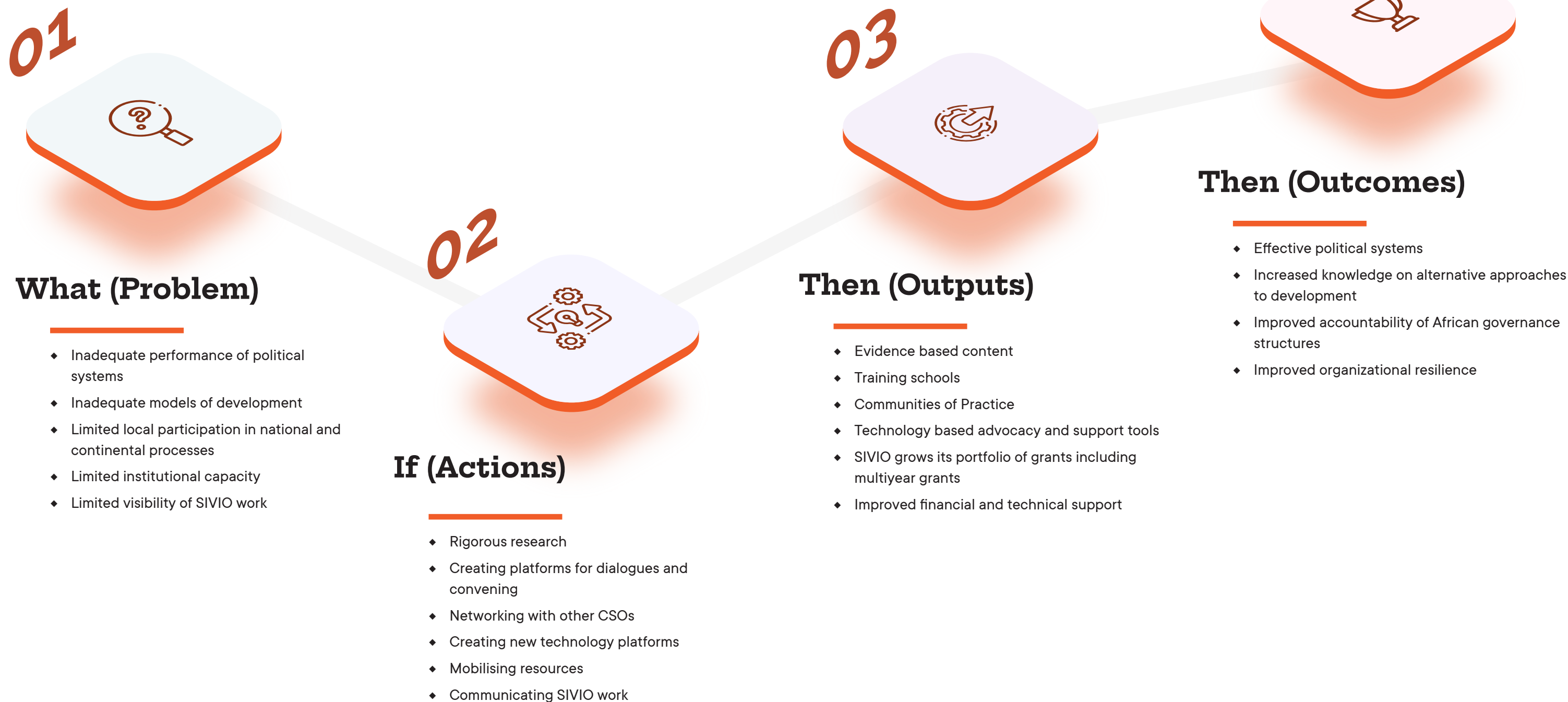
What will we work on:
